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## APPENDIX B STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTEREST DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

1	All investments, interests in real property and income (including gifts), and any business entity in which the person is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holds any position of management. Financial interests are reportable only if 1) they are located within the boundary of the CPD, as defined in the supporting materials to San Diego City Council Resolution No. 300586, or 2) they are subject to the jurisdiction of the CPD, or 3) the business entity is doing business or planning to do business in the CPD or has done business within the CPD at any time during the two years prior to filing the statement. An interest in real property that is used as a personal residence is not required to be disclosed, unless the residence is also used for business purposes.
2	Consultants shall be included in the list of designated members and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation:
	The City's Deputy Director for City Planning and Community Investment may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based on that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements.
	The Deputy Director's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.
